### **Sketchbook.....10%**

*Required for projects and drawing practice.*

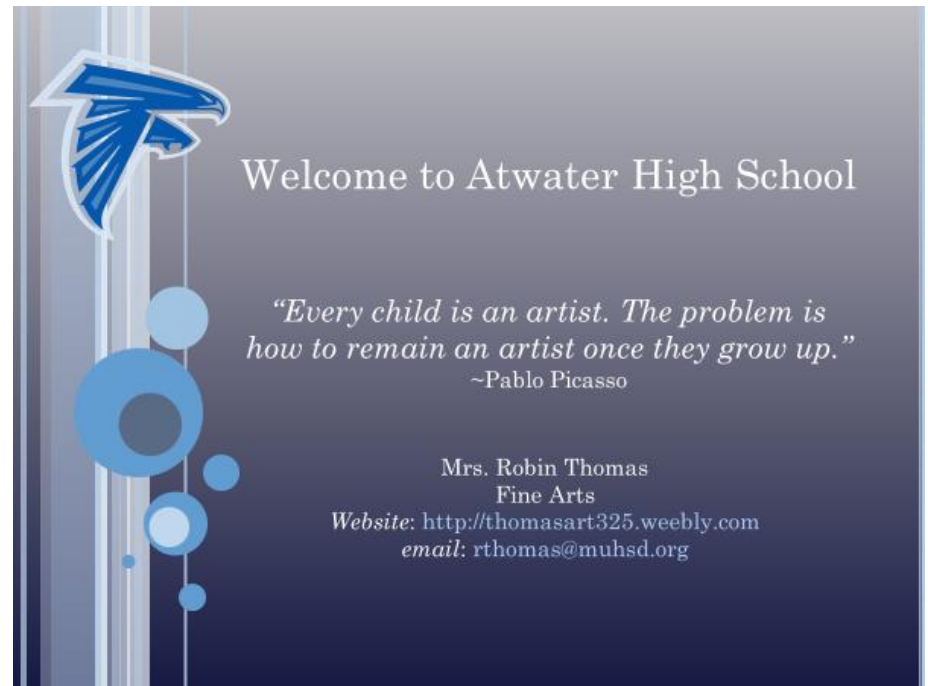
**\*\* There is a 2 day "grace period" for artwork with no grade penalty. Following the grace period, work will be graded "as is".**

## Procedures For Cell Phone Use:

- \*You may NOT use your Cell phone during lecture or instruction.
- \*You may ONLY listen to music when I give you permission to do so.
- \*You may only have 1 ear bud in at a time, not both.
- \*Keep your music at a reasonable volume.
- \*You may use your phone to look up images when the assignment requires you to illustrate your own image.
- \*Cell phones need to be placed on the desk while listening to music or looking at an image.

Discipline action will be enforced if procedures are not followed.\* 1<sup>st</sup> Offense - I will ask you to put your phone/computer away. 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense - I take it for the period. 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense - I ask a liaison to come get your phone/you.

**\*\*If a liaison needs to take your device from you, a parent or guardian will need to pick it up. It will not be released back to you.**
